A Message from the Executive Director

Keeping the Central Business District businesses alive and well has been a major priority for Downtown San Angelo, Inc. as we kick-off 2021. The anticipation of continued progress in controlling the spread of COVID-19 and keeping the doors open for all businesses are positive indicators for the future development of our community.

The Chadbourne Street Re-Design kicked-off on January 12, 2021 at the intersection of Concho Ave. and South Chadbourne Street moving South towards the South Chadbourne Street Bridge. The preliminary phase of construction has been receiving unprecedent support from both property and business owners. Downtown San Angelo, Inc. has been at the forefront of assisting the City of San Angelo and the team of engineering and construction companies implementing this monumental task, by facilitating meetings and discussion with our downtown constituents to address their concerns and solutions to resolve issues being created by the constructions. As a result, the community has responded largely with a positive resounding support for this project. Our Media partners in conjunction with the City of San Angelo Public Information Office have provided the public with constant communication of the street detours and how to get to businesses being impacted by the construction. Social Media has played a significant role in getting the word to the community of what to expect but more importantly how to get to business impacted.

Our Downtown Historic Gateway and Leading Lights projects also kicked-off and construction has begun in establishing Historic Street Lights at the intersection of South Koenigheim and West Concho Ave. that will lead up to the Historic Gateway (arch) at the intersection of West Concho Ave and Randolph. The Historic Gateway will welcome visitors and our community in the Heart of the City.

The initial phase of the South Chadbourne Street Re-Design and the Leading Lights and Historic Gateway are estimated to be completed by mid-February.

Our Downtown Strong and Brews Ewe and BBQ Cook-off are slated to start promoting and bring out the community and tourist to the Central Business District. The Brews Ewe & BBQ Cook-Off will kick-off March 5 – 6, 2021 at our new location "Neff's Park" along the river banks of the Concho River. While we launch the Downtown Strong campaign on Thursday, February 11, 2021 in Celebration of Valentine Day!

Downtown San Angelo, Inc. is committed to preserving our historical roots and buildings in keeping with the Texas Historical Commission – Main Street City program criteria. Solidifying the 14th year Downtown San Angelo, Inc. has received the National Accreditation from the National Main Street City Center.

Up-and-Coming DSA Inc. Projects

W. Concho Gateway and Streetlights

The implementation of a gateway and historic streetlights on the 200 block of West Concho are underway. The projects have gained steam in making this dream a reality for DSA and supporters of downtown. A longtime goal of the organization, establishing a gateway signifying entrance to the historic downtown district is moving forward. Additionally, new yet historic lighting will be placed from Koenigheim Street leading up to the gateway. The gateway itself will straddle Concho, and will be placed just past South Randolph Street.

Investing in historic downtown is a fundamental belief of Downtown San Angelo, Inc. Being able to develop the district by implementing capital projects such as the gateway and complementary lighting not only enhance the district as a whole, but set precedence for future improvements to take place. The organization is grateful to have the support of the City of San Angelo as well as businesses across the area in these efforts.

DSA is extremely grateful to have received grant funding and private donations to achieve the total fundraising goal to carry out the street lighting along West Concho Avenue. Institutions such as the San Angelo Health Foundation, the San Angelo YMCA, First Financial Bank, and the San Angelo Area Foundation serve as leaders within our community, and it would not be possible without their Board's generosity that the organization could pursue something on this scale.

The gateway and streetlights will serve to set precedence for capital projects downtown with the hope to eventually replace the contemporary street lighting throughout downtown with light posts that are reminiscent and characteristic of the historic downtown district. As complimentary pieces to the greater work which will be the gateway, Downtown San Angelo, Inc. also hopes to have

several gateways within downtown signifying an entrance to the district.

The organization would like to thank all of its supporters, partners and members as we engage in this process. It is the widespread confidence in DSA that allows us to pursue projects such as this and reinvest in the betterment of downtown as a whole.






