

HISTORY

FIBERGLASS SHEEP ESTABLISHED IN 2007

1877

John Arden and Joseph
Tweedy introduced sheep
ranching in 1877. Agriculture,
ranching, and later the oil and gas
industry became the most important
factors in the economy. Wool
growers, cattle ranchers, and the
railroads combined to make San
Angelo one of the leading cattle
markets in Texas, the largest sheep
market in the United States, and one
of the leading inland wool and
mohair markets in the nation.

**San Angelo was once named the Wool Capital of the World.

2007

The idea of painted fiberglass sheep began in 2007 when the Downtown San Angelo, Inc. promotions committee decided herding fiberglass ewes was easier than reorganizing the Miss Wool of Texas Pageant that had taken place 1952-72. Read more about the Miss Wool Pagaent at TexasArchive.org.
